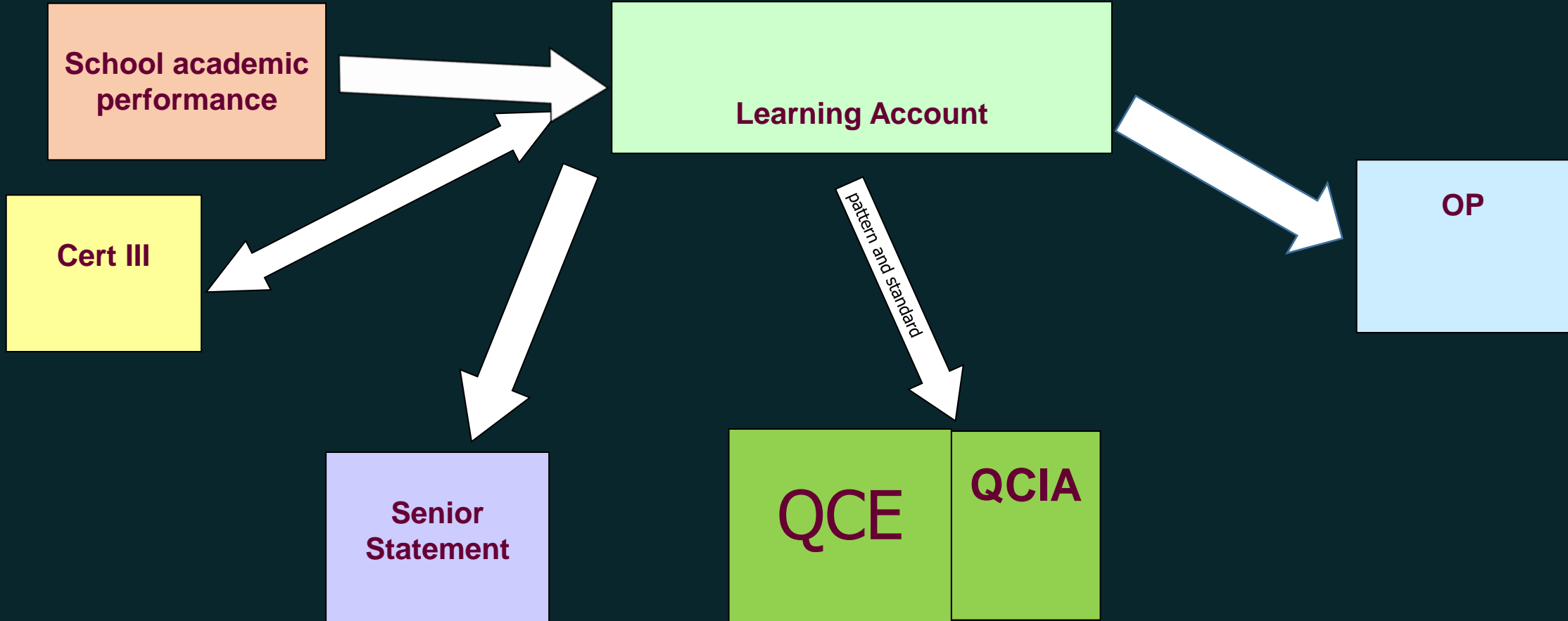

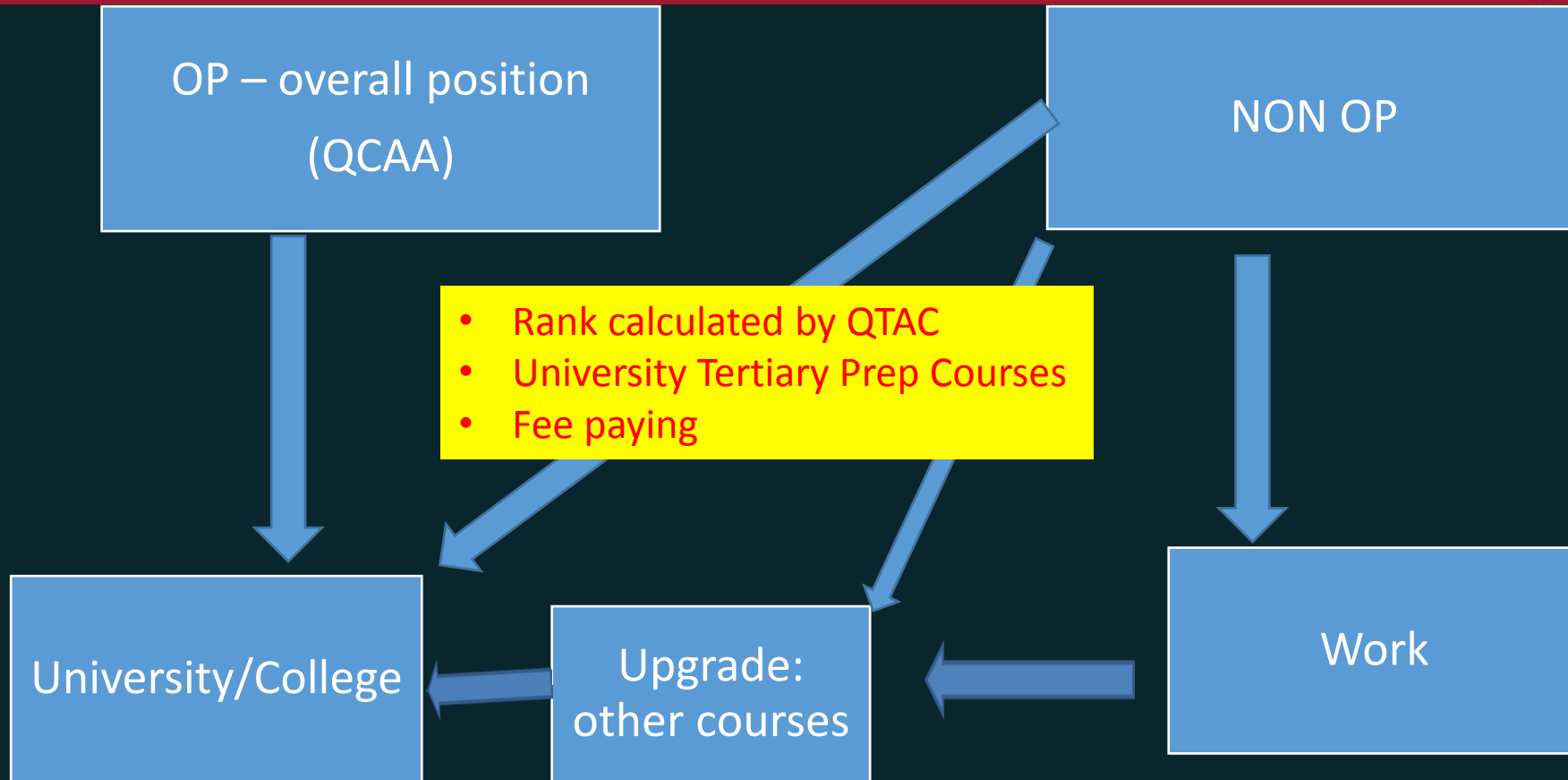

# Authority Registered Subjects



- Authority Registered Subjects are written to a study plan as outlined by the Queensland Studies Authority.
- These subjects are often studied by students who do not intend to take a direct pathway to University
- Each subject on successful completion contributes four points towards the attainment of the Queensland Certificate of Education.

# Certificate Courses



- Certificate II in Hospitality and Tourism (4 QCE Points)
- \*Online Certificate courses for example: Business, Health, Electronics, Sports & Recreation, Early Childhood, Educational support (Cert III courses provide 6 – 8 QCE points)

# School-Based Apprenticeships & Traineeships



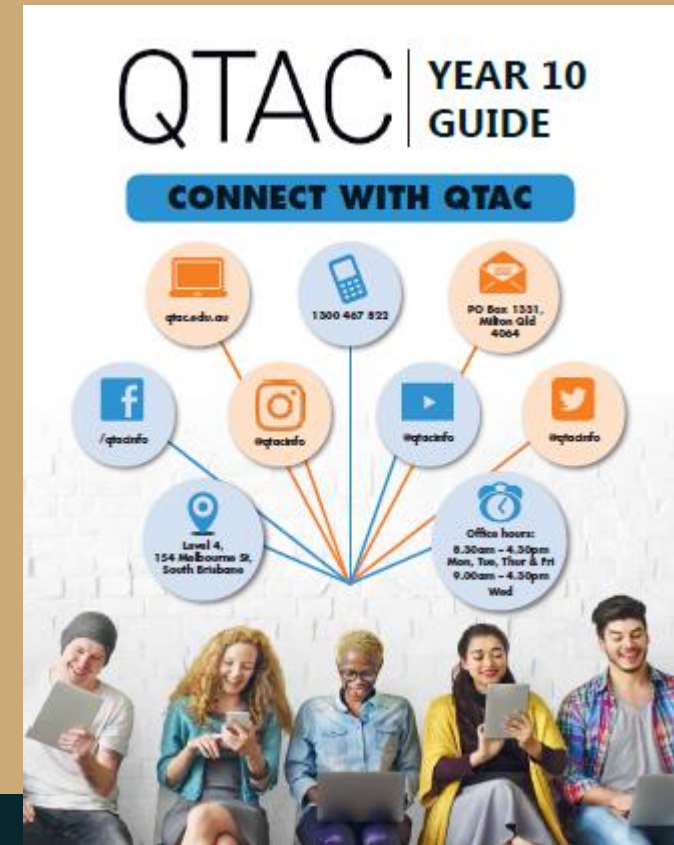
- Work based training; certificates offered in a specific area
- Certificates are offered by the workplace not the College
- Develop the employability skills whilst experiencing the expectations of work
- Completion may take 12 to 18 months (Minimum 350hrs or approx. *50 days/year in the workplace*)
- Difficult to combine OP course in Years 11 & 12 and traineeship / school-based apprenticeship
- QCE points for successful completion of Cert III (6 points)

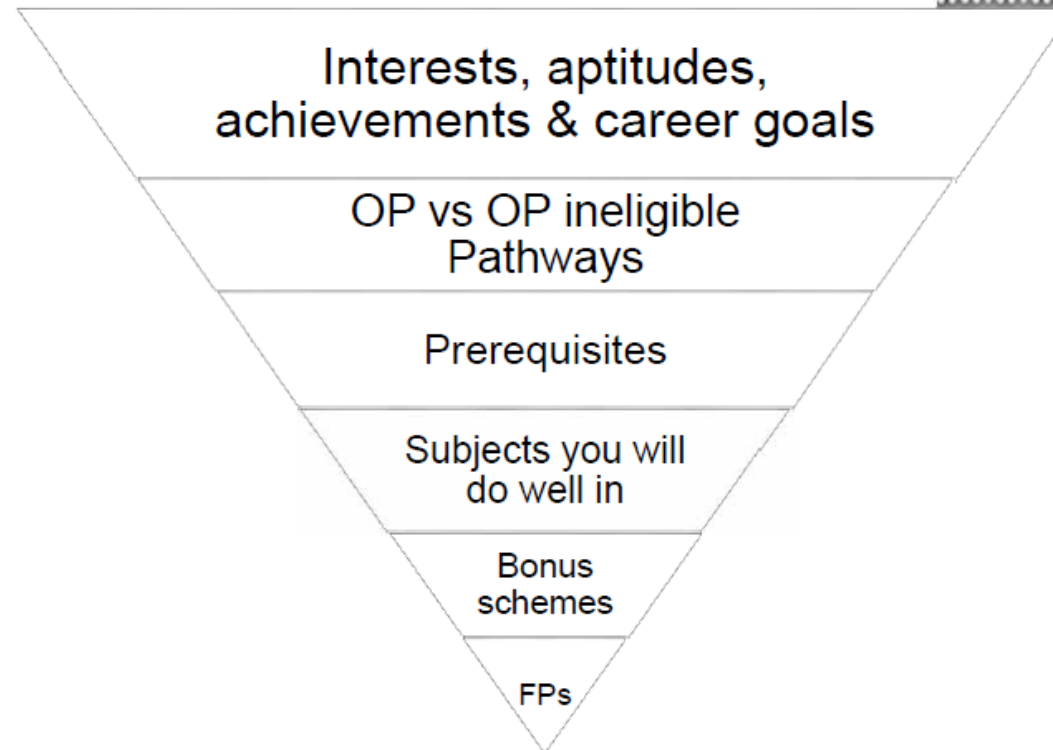
